

Nevaeh's Star

Finished size: 16-1/4" x 16-1/4"

Materials

1/2 yard beige fabric
for center block and border
7/8 yard green print fabric
for border, backing and binding
6" square orange print fabric
for star appliqué
1/2 yard backing fabric
18" x 18" square of batting
Quantities are for 40/44"-wide,
100% cotton fabrics. Measurements
include 1/4" seam allowances. Sew
with right sides together unless
otherwise stated.

Cut the Fabrics

From beige fabric, cut:

- 1—12" square.
- 1—6-1/2" square. Cut the square diagonally in an X for a total of 4 A triangles for border.
- 3—5" squares. Cut each square diagonally in an X for a total of 8 C triangles for border and 4 C triangles for corners.

From green print fabric, cut:

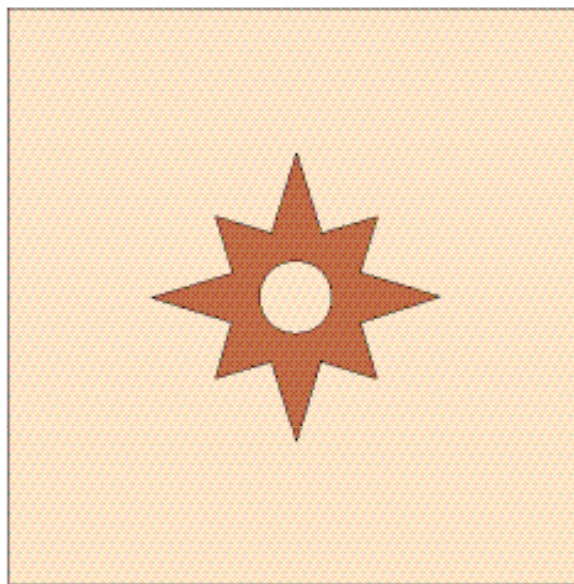
- 1—5" square. Cut the square diagonally in an X for a total of 4 D triangles for corners.
- 2—6-1/2" squares. Cut each square diagonally in an X for a total of 8 B triangles for border.
- 2—2-1/2" x 42" strips for binding.

From orange print fabric, cut:

- Trace 1 Star pattern using the template provided. Cut and prepare the appliqué shape using the orange print fabric and the appliqué method of your choice.

Center Block Assembly

1. Position the Star appliqué on the center of the 12" beige square.
2. Appliqué the Star in place using your favorite method. Press the appliqué block from the back. Trim the block to 11" square, centering the star appliqué before trimming.

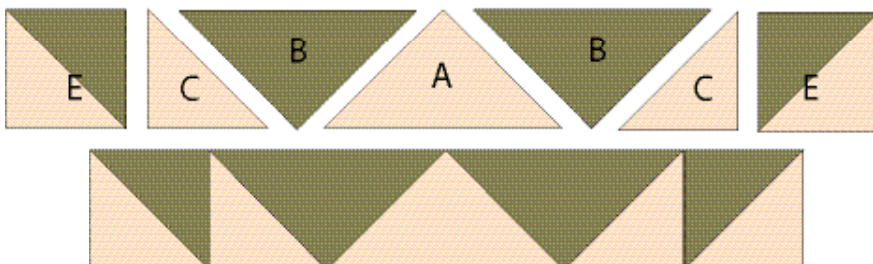


Border Assembly

1. Layer a beige C triangle and green D triangle, right sides together. Sew along the long edge. Press the half-square triangle open to make 1 E Unit. Make 4 E Units.



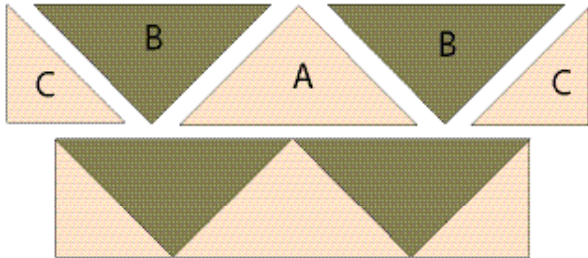
2. Lay out 2 E Units, 2 beige C triangles, 2 green B triangles, and 1 beige A triangle in a row. Sew the pieces together to make a top/bottom border. Make 2 top/bottom borders.



Top/Bottom Border Assembly Diagram

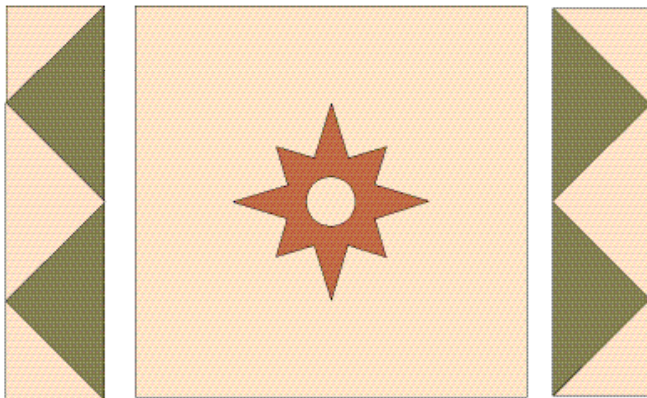


3. Lay out 2 beige C triangles, 2 B green triangles, and 1 beige A triangle in a row. Sew the pieces together to make a side border. Make 2 side borders.

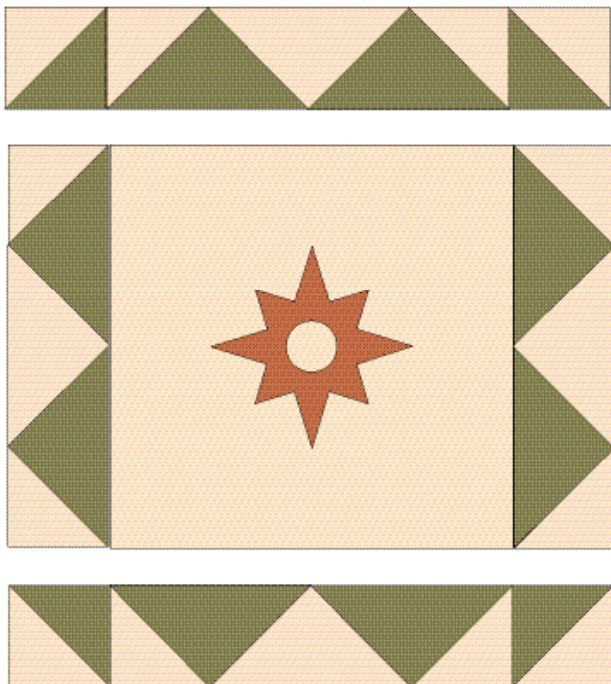


Side Border Assembly Diagram

4. Sew the 2 side borders to opposite sides of the center block. Press seams toward the center block.

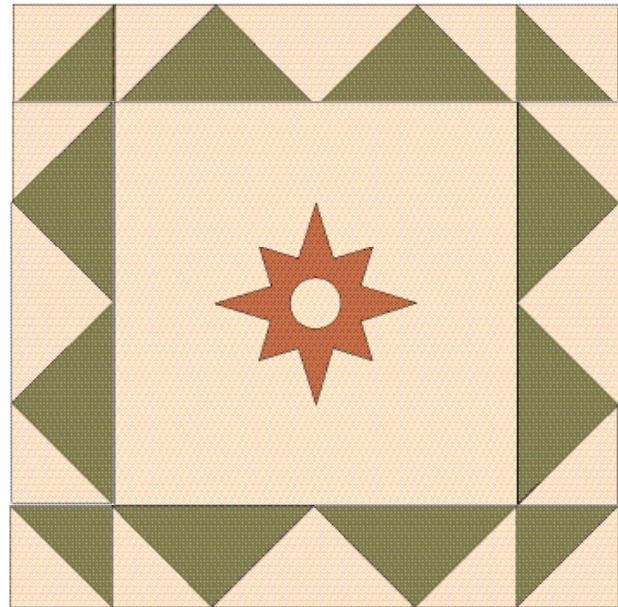


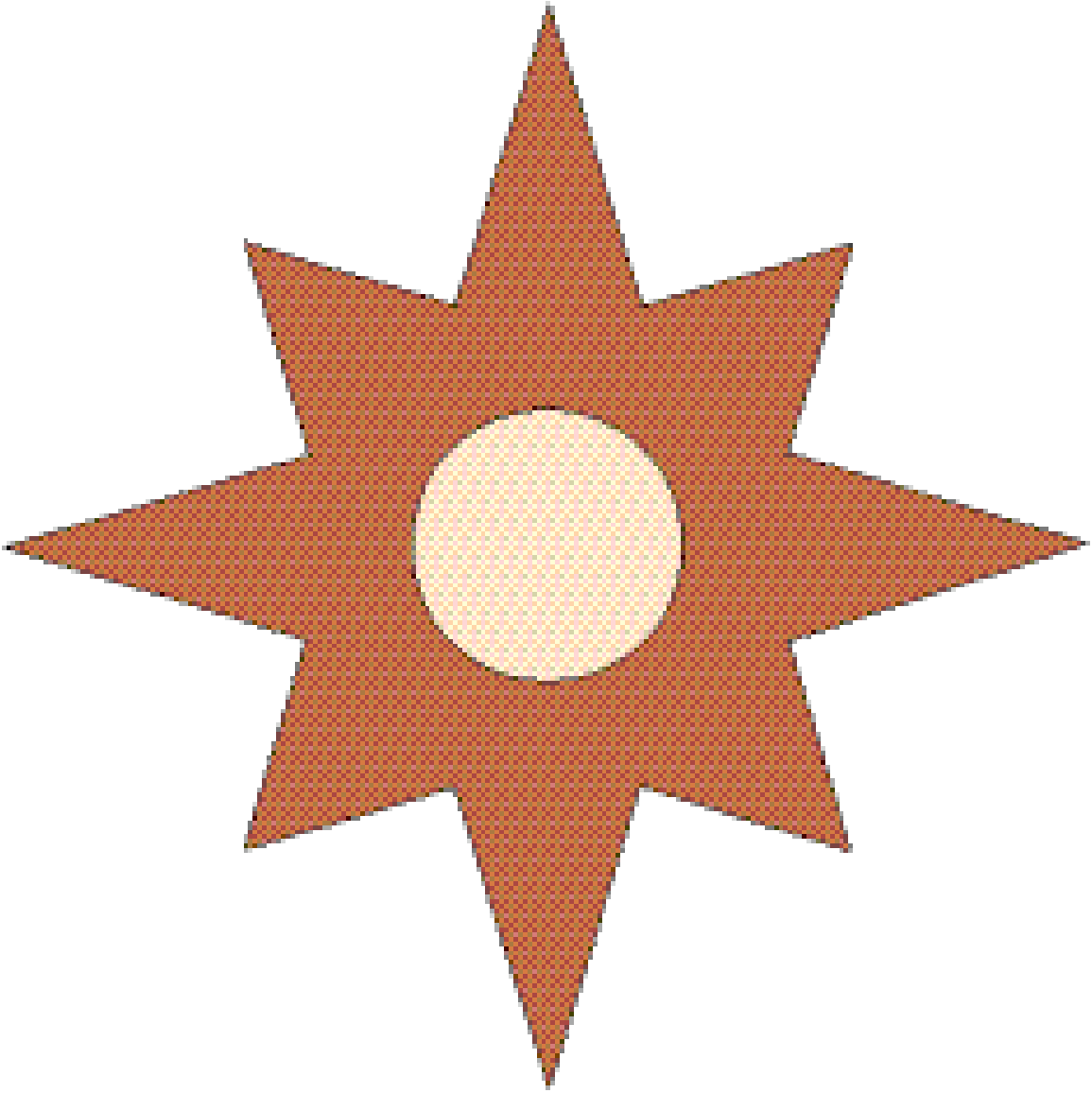
5. Sew the top/bottom borders to the top and bottom of the center block. Press seams toward the border.



Complete the Quilt

1. Layer quilt top, batting and backing.
2. Quilt the layers together as desired.
3. Sew the binding strips together to make one long continuous strip. Attach the binding to the outside edges to finish the quilt.
