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## Fabrics

### Light Green Print Fabric:

1/4 yard for Pieced Appliqué™ blocks

### Medium Yellow Print Fabric:

1/4 yard for Pieced Appliqué™ blocks and backing

### Dark Paisley Print Fabric:

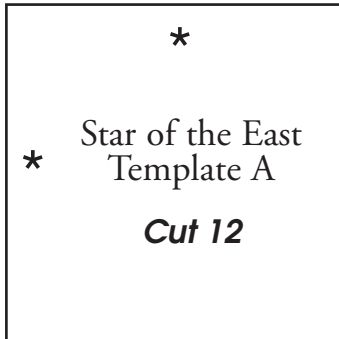
1/2 yard for setting triangles, border, and binding

### Light Yellow Print Fabric:

1/2 yard for backing

*Refer to General Instructions on pages 8-19 before beginning this project.*

**Note:** All yardage requirements are based on 44"-wide fabric, NOT pre-washed. Measurements include 1/4" seam allowance.



## Star of the East Pieced Appliqué™ Blocks

### Cutting

#### Light Green Print Fabric:

#1—Cut 6—6" squares

#### Medium Yellow Print Fabric:

#2—Cut 6—6" squares

Scraps to Cut 12 of Appliqué A

#### Paper Templates:

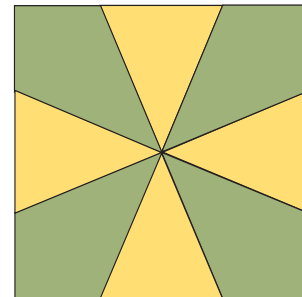
Cut 12 of Template A

### Make 3—Star of the East Pieced Appliqué™ Blocks

### Piecing

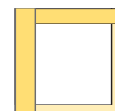
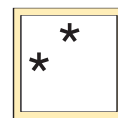
*This block consists of 12 pieces.*

- 1 Following the kaleidoscope foundation block directions, make akaleidoscope block with the #1 lightgreen print fabric squares and the #2medium yellow print fabric squares. Trim the kaleidoscope so that the light green print fabric will form the corners of the block.



- 2 Glue the A paper templates to the wrong side of a scrap of dark print fabric. Trim the fabric EXACTLY 1/4" away from all sides of the templates. Turn two adjoining sides of the A appliqués.

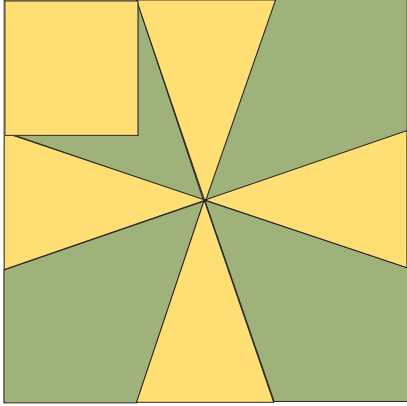
**Note:** \* on paper templates indicates which side to turn.



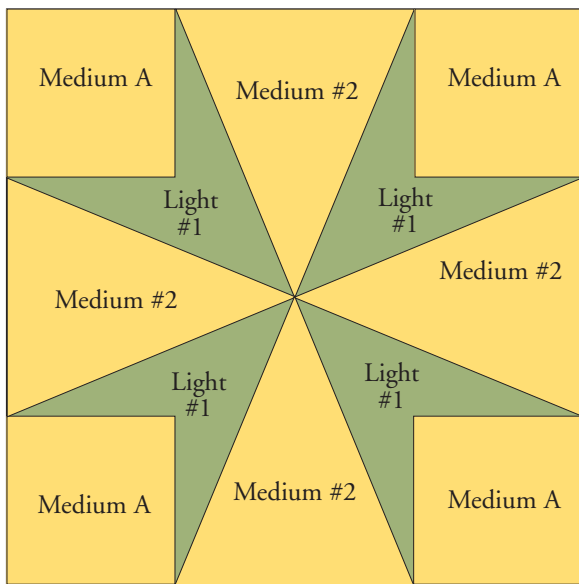
Template A



3 Glue the wrong side of the appliqué in place on the pieced kaleidoscope block. The raw edges of the appliqué should be placed even with the raw edges of the corners of the kaleidoscope foundation block.



4 Appliqué in place, leaving raw edges open. Place the appliqué block in warm water to dissolve the glue. After approximately 20 minutes, squeeze the excess water from the block and smooth it out on a towel. After the block has dried, pull out the paper templates along the raw edges of the block. Smooth the block out again and press.



5 Repeat Steps 1-4 to make a total of 3 Star of the East blocks.

## Setting Triangles

### Cutting

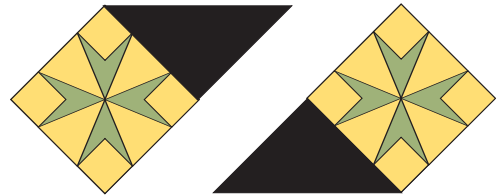
#### Dark Paisley Print Fabric:

Cut 1—11" square

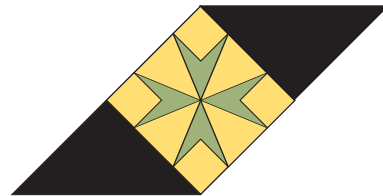
1 Cut the 11" square in half diagonally twice to make four setting triangles. These triangles will be over-sized.



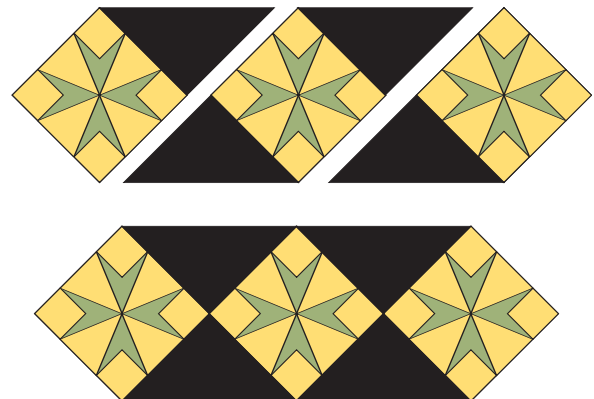
2 Sew a setting triangle to one side of two Star of the East blocks, as shown.



3 Sew a setting triangle to opposite sides of one Star of the East block, as shown.



4 Lay the segments out, as shown, and sew together in rows.





## Borders & Binding

### Cutting

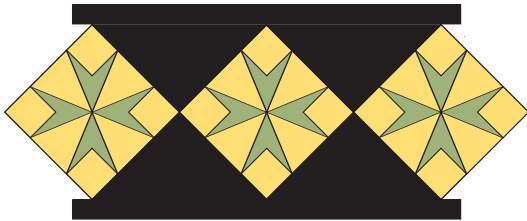
#### Dark Paisley Print Fabric:

Cut 2—3" strips for borders

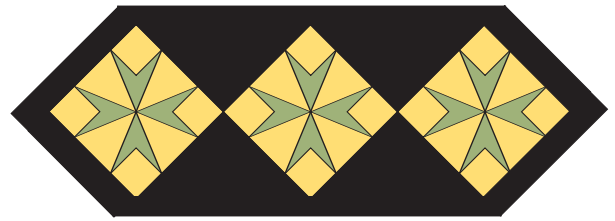
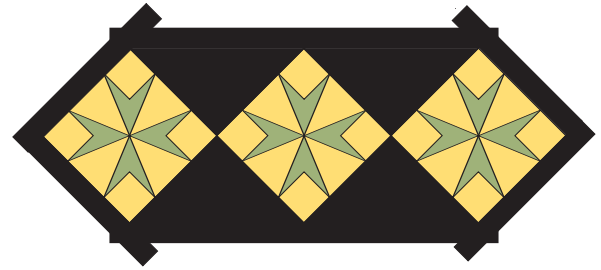
Cut 3—2-1/4" strips for binding

1 Measure the two long sides of the table runner center. Add 1" to the measurement. Cut the two 3" strips to the measurement calculated.

2 Sew one of the strips to each long side of the table runner. Press.



3 Sew the remaining 3" strips to each end of the table runner. Trim away excess fabric.



4 Layer table runner top, batting, and backing together. Quilt and bind as desired.

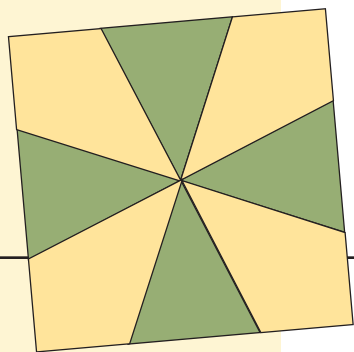
Substitute your favorite Pieced Appliqué™ block in the Eastern Star Table Runner.

# Kaleidoscope Foundation Block



A Kaleidoscope Block is cut from a pinwheel block.

Make a sample block to learn the technique before cutting the fabric for your quilt.

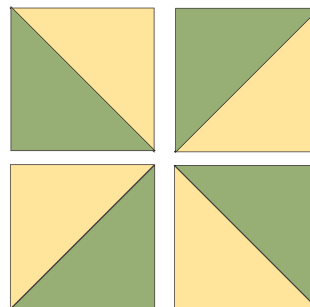
## FABRICS

Cut 2—6" Squares from Light Fabric

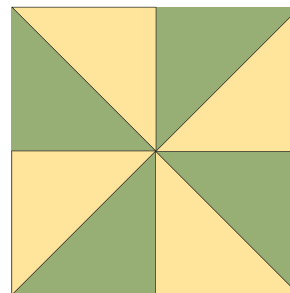
Cut 2—6" Squares from Dark Fabric

## PIECING

**1** Make four half-square triangles from the 6" squares of light and dark fabrics by placing a square of each fabric right sides together, marking across the diagonal, and sewing a 1/4" seam on either side of the line. Cut on the line and press the seams open. Each set of squares yields two half-square triangles. Trim these finished half-square triangles to 5".

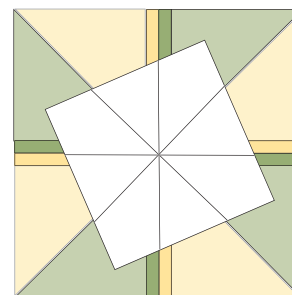


**2** Sew four half-square triangles together to form a pinwheel. Press the seams open.

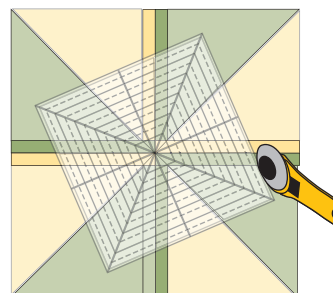


## CUTTING THE KALEIDOSCOPE:

**3** Glue the kaleidoscope template to the wrong side of the pinwheel block, matching the lines on the template to the seam lines of the pinwheel. The kaleidoscope block instructions state which fabric should be on the corners. Place the template accordingly.



**4** Place the 6-1/2" Creative Grids™ Square It Up & Fussy Cut ruler on top of the template so that the 1/4" seam extends beyond the template on all sides.

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5 Cut around the ruler on all sides.
