She is allowed to share the quilt with her grandchildren, but she gets to keep the magic!*

Finished size approximately 53" x 65"

Block size: 8" x 15"

Fabric collection: Flower Fairies by Michael Miller

WOF = Width of fabric.

NOTE: Sew all blocks with a scant 1/4" seam.

## Materials

Fabric A—1 Fairies Panel (blocks)

Fabric B—1-1/2 yards Green Small Print  
(blocks, spacers, binding)

Fabric C—3/4 yard Rust Small Print (blocks, borders)

Fabric D—5/8 yard Ivory Small Print (spacers)

Fabric E—5/8 yard Leaf Print (spacers)

Fabric F—1 yard Flower Fairies Print (borders)

Backing—4-1/8 yards

## Cut the Fabrics

### From Fabric A, cut:

NOTE: Apply fusible web to back of fabric before cutting.

Fussy cut (9) Fairy rectangles (all the same size, with or without borders and lettering)

Fussy cut (30) Small berry/flowers

### From Fabric B, cut:

3 strips, 8-1/2" x WOF; from these strips cut:

(5) 8-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles

3 strips, 3-3/8" x WOF; from these strips cut:

(30) 3-3/8" squares

6 strips, 2-1/4" x WOF; sew strips together end-to-end to make binding

### From Fabric C, cut:

2 strips, 8-1/2" x WOF; from these strips cut:

(4) 8-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles

5 strips, 1-1/2" x WOF; from these strips cut:

(2) 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" strips

(2) 1-1/2" x 52-1/2" strips

### From Fabric D, cut:

2 strips, 2-7/8" x WOF; from these strips cut:

(24) 2-7/8" squares, cut in half on diagonal once to make 48 half-square triangles

2 strips, 5-1/4" x WOF; from these strips cut:

(9) 5-1/4" squares, cut in half on diagonal twice to make 36 quarter-square triangles

### From Fabric E, cut:

1 strip, 8-1/2" x WOF; from this strip cut:

(4) 8-1/2" squares

3 strips, 4-1/2" x WOF; from these strips cut:

(6) 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips

(6) 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips

### From Fabric F, cut:

5 strips, 6" x WOF; from these strips cut:

(2) 6" x 53-1/2" strips

(2) 6" x 54-1/2" strips
